French he/she needs to take and at what level. If based on TEF placement test results students have to take additional French courses as prerequisites, the latter will not count towards the degree. Students may not take French in their first semester of study, and they can also be exempted upon earning a minimum of C1 in TEF and 16 in GAT. International students with no prior knowledge of French may choose to take Spanish to satisfy GenEd language requirements.
